## Haslingfield Commuting

 TRUMPINGTON ESTATE Public and Permissive Hights of Way



Residents of Haslingfield may cycle or walk along the private farm road between Haslingfield and Grantchester villages subject to the following conditions:

1. Written permission MUST be gained from Richard Pemberton, The Estate Office, Trumpington Farm Company, Cantelupe Farm, Haslingfield, Cambridge CB23 1LY. Any permission granted is personal and does not extend to wider family members or friends. Anybody found using the route without written permission will be asked to leave the farm.
2. Access is allowed for commuting purposes only, or for doing the school run at normal 'rush hour' times morning and evening. The farm road is not to be used outside these hours. The farm road may NOT be used for leisure or recreation purposes at any time. Permission may be withdrawn at any time and for any reason without prior consultation.
3. Anyone seen dropping litter will have permission withdrawn immediately.
4. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
5. Cyclists and walkers must immediately give way to farm vehicles and other traffic at all times.
6. For safety reasons, head/ear phones must not be used when cycling through the farm. High-viz clothing and functioning front & rear lights must be used during the hours of darkness. Anybody found using the road during the hours of darkness without lights will be banned from using the road again.
7. Insurance liability:- The directors and employees of Trumpington Farm Company, Cantelupe Farm residents and the Pemberton Trustees will not be held responsible or liable for any loss or damage to your property or accident involving yourselves.

Anybody cycling through the farm must have sufficient third-party liability cover in place at all times in the event that they have an accident.
